These training sessions are for the purpose of helping employers train their employees in the safe handling and application of pesticides as required by state regulations. A verification of pesticide training attendance will be issued to those who attend.

In addition to this training, employers are still required to provide and document annual training in specific pesticides to be used. Continuing education hours have been requested. Individuals with the following certificates **will receive 2.5 hours continuing education credit, which includes 1.5 hours of laws and regulations and 1.0 hour of other.** Only one session may be attended for credit.

Private applicator certificate
Agricultural pest control advisor license

Qualified applicator license
Qualified applicator certificate

Other certificate or license holders should call the Dept. of Pesticide Regulations regarding certification of continuing education credits.
